



PENNSYLVANIA VOLUNTEER CLEARANCES

Per Pennsylvania state law, all LPEP volunteers must have the appropriate clearances on file at each school you intend to volunteer.

The District requires the following clearances:

1. Pennsylvania Child Abuse History Clearance (Act 151)
2. Pennsylvania State Police Criminal Record Check (Act 34)
3. FBI Federal Criminal History Record (Act 114) OR Volunteers who have resided in Pennsylvania for ALL of the past ten years may request a waiver of the FBI Fingerprint Clearance.
4. In addition to the clearances listed above, the Acknowledgement of Volunteer Obligations form must be signed and submitted with the clearance documents.

Acquiring the clearance documents takes time and we recommend that parents planning on volunteering in the schools complete the process as soon as possible. The documents will remain on file with the District for 3 years at which time new clearances will be necessary.
