Mr. Campos advised that the Middle School will be utilizing LPEP's \$3000 donation to redesign the cafeteria as well as construct a fitness room. This includes wall art, new counter, stools, and fitness mats. The students are assisting with this project by submitting their designs. Mr. Campos is also hoping to secure a grant to assist with these projects.

Mr. Schweinberg explained that the \$3000 donation will be used to words STEM equipment as well as creating a STEM section in the East Union Library.

Mrs. Cavalancia informed the group that the \$3000 donation is going to be put towards revamping the computer lab. The lab is being redesigned to include a messy maker area, technology area, and brainstorming section. The donation will be used towards items such as dry erase board paint and furniture. The school is working with our high school students to build Lego boards, peg boards, other items for the space.
